Cascais is a village that was inhabited from Romans to Muslims.


During the second half of the XII century, Cascais was a small village of fishermen and farmers, becoming, due to its privilege geographical position of its bay, a very competitive fishing harbor.

This is an on-line e-tournament in real time through the ZOOM platform. The organizing committee will provide with all the required information's step by step to assist all the participants during the event.

All participants will be assessed by 5 referees from our Karate National Body. The 1st referee will accumulate the function of tatami leader.

All the event will stream online as well the performance results.

Considering that we are using ZOOM a TATAMI is a ZOOM meeting room.

PERFORMANCE IMAGES


The athlete can present its performance from anywhere (DOJO, LIVING ROOM, OUTSIDE) as long as there is enough space to present the whole kata, in a flat area, assuring that all the body of the athlete is visible during the performance.

If there is a video signal failure, signal loss during the presentation, the athlete will be disqualified.


Be sure that the selected place is quiet and provides good lighting conditions, free of any obstacles that may cause injury.

CAMERA POSITIONING

If outside, do not position the camera against direct sunlight When positioning the camera, make sure the distance is big enough to record all of the necessary area for your performance, and the athlete is visible throughout the entire performance (Graph 1).



Do not put the camera on the floor – we recommend a height of minimum 80 cm. If you don't have a tripod, use a table or other stable object etc. (Graph 2)



KATA PERFORMANCE

The athlete can connect from any proper device like a Smartphone, Tablet, Laptop, Camera, as long they can access the proper zoom meeting link.

It is mandatory for an athlete announce his(ers) name and the kata out loud in an audible form.

The performance must start with all the starting and final rituals including the bows, specific to the kata performance.

The athlete will be removed from the meeting back to the waiting room after the presentation of the final score or by instructions of the tatami leader.

IMPOTANTE NOTES:

If the internet connection fails or freezes during the kata presentation, the performing athlete will be disqualified.

This is an on-line live event with real time presentation, with multiple tatamis (zoom meeting rooms), in the case of conflicting schedule, the image capture is entirely of the athlete's responsibility being the organizing committee not liable for simultaneous calls to the tatamis.

TOURNAMENT GENERAL RULES AND SETUP

The general rules for this tournament are the WKF rules (Cadets and seniors) and the FNK-P (children, initiates and juveniles).

Each tatami is composed by 5 referees and an official. The 1st referee is the tatami leader.

This a seeding and point system event.

The age for the categories are determined by the athletes age in the day of the event.

The e-Tournament will be held with different categories, separated by age, males and females:

Children	Up 9 years old	24 maximum enrolments
Initiates	10 – 11 years old	24 maximum enrolments
Juveniles	12 – 13 years old	24 maximum enrolments
Cadets	14 – 15 years old	24 maximum enrolments
Seniors	16+ years old	24 maximum enrolments

The competitors will have to presente the minimum of 2 diferent basic katas from the oficial WKF list, alternated in each round.	The competitors must presente in the 1st round 1 basic kata from the oficial WKF kata list. From the 2nd and 3rd round the competitor can presente a kata from the above list according to the Karate Style. On the 4th round the competitor can repeat the presented katas as long its not the same kata from the previous round, and only one time. (The competitor can only repeat a kata one time)	The competitor must present 3 diferente katas from the oficial WKF kata list, in the 1st 3 rounds. From the 4th round the competitor can repeat the presented katas as long its not the same kata from the previous round, and only one time

- a) It is importante that the presented kata is from the competitor original style;
- b) In these categories it is permited the use of spectacles during the presentation.

Enrolment fee is 12,50€ per category until November 14th, from November the 15th onward the enrolment fee is 15,00€.

Any changes or repeats will be of the tatami leader responsibility, in accordance with the referee committee.

All athletes must be in the meeting room 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time of the performance to mark the presence and inform the kata name.

Only the competitors can bee in the zoom meeting, all coaches can inform of any irregularity by the athletes chat to the tatami official.

E-Tournament Scoring

All the scores will be displayed on-line and live, after the competitor performance.
