

COMPETITION RULES

The **1st European Seiwakai Championship** will be held on **October 22, 2023** starting at 9:00 a.m. and ending at 5:00 p.m., and will take place at the **Pavilhão do Grupo Desportivo de Sesimbra** in Lisbon Metropolitan Area - Portugal

- 1. The **1st Seiwakai Championship** is for Seiwakai Members and will comprise individual Kata and Kumite competition at all levels, and also with team events at senior levels only.
- 2. All rules will be in accordance with the **WKF** (World Karate Federation) regulations with the exception of some parameters mentioned in these rules for the event.
- 3. *All referees elected* to the panel should hold the official course of the National Federation of Karate linked with **WKF** in order to ensure a quality tournament.
- 4. All referees wishing to participate in our event should contact previously the organization.
- 5. An entrance fee will be charged to the public in the value of 1 "Kiai" and will have the offer of 1 bottle of water, participants registered on the European Seminar and Championship have free admission.
- 6. *Registrations* will start at 00:00 hours on August 08, 2023 and close at 23:59 hours on October 15, 2023, they will be made on the Kimura platform:

- 7. For the entries to be validated, the payment of the fees must be settled within 24 hours after their registration, or contacting by phone or e-mail the organization for any other methodology.
 - 8. The value of the registrations is:
 - *Until September 15th* | 15€ per individual and category;
 - Between 16 September and 15 October: 20€ per category;
 - Coaches: 1 Free | More than one: Add 5€

- 9. Any change after the end of the registrations will have an administrative cost of 25ϵ .
- 10. The mentioned amounts must be settled by the deadline of each deadline by bank transfer to the NKGR from Lisbon Seiwakai Branch in Portugal by IBAN: PT5000 0700 000038223344823, and asking the validation of the registration.
- 11. The draw of the tournament will be held on October 16, 2023 by the kimura platform, it will be announced on October 17, 2023 with the respective provisional program sent to all registered clubs.
- 12. Complaints must be made between October 17, 2023 and October 19, 2023, the final draw of the categories where changes have occurred will be sent and exposed on the event.
- 13. The organization will provide the medical support compatible with the tournament, but is not responsible for the accidents that occurred during the tournament, and it is obligatory that individuals have sports insurance for the expenses and risk of the individuals participating on the tournament.
 - 14. Counts the age of the athletes at the time of the tournament (22 October 2023)
- 15. The organization reserves the right to cancel an event if it does not have the sufficient number of registrations.
- 16. If the control table so requests, the identification of the competitors will be made through the citizen card or passport.
- 17. The organization does not provide the proof sheets so each club must have the proof sheets printed and sent previously.
- 18. In case of protest, the intention must be communicated to the table as soon as the event in question is finished, you will have to ask the table for the official form of the protest. It will have a cost of \in 50, value that will be returned back if the protest is accepted and the given reason to the protester.

In all classes the events will take place by the point system following the WKF rules, except for the following exceptions:

- · Only Goju-Ryu-style katas listed in Annex 1 will be allowed in all Kata categories.
- · In the Children and Kids categories:
 - □ Athletes may present any Kata listed in Annex list.
 - ☐ Children can repeat the Kata in every round
 - ☐ *Kids will be able to alternately repeat the Kata*
- In the MiniCadets to Veteran categories
 - ☐ They will have to present a different kata in every round.
- If a tiebreaker is required, it will take place according to the parameters described in the rules in force (WKF) and adaptation by the rules here.
- Classes with fewer than four athletes join the men's series with women's in Kata.
- The use of glasses is allowed in all kata categories, however we recommend that from the Cadet level contact lenses or sports glasses are used.
- Each club can have one team only registered, teams can be of 3 or 4 elements, can have Male and Female athletes at the same team. Senior team can have 16 years old athletes and up.

In all classes, the races will take place by the points system following the rules in force in the WKF regulations, except for the following exceptions:

- Kumite classes with less than 4 athletes join the next or previous series in the case of the higher categories.
- \square Teams can have a minimum of 2 elements, in that case if a 3^{rd} match is required the team with 2 elements loses the match. A substitute could be registred in each team.

• Kumite duration:

- Children (≤ 9 years): 1 minute;
- *Kids (10/11 years): 1 minute;*
- *Mini-Cadets (12/13 years) 1:30 minutes;*
- Cadets, Juniors and Seniors: 2 minutes.

• Mandatory Protections:

- Mouthpiece, Gloves, and leg protection of the color AKA or AO are mandatory in all levels.
- Optional Chest Protection Vest only in the Infant, Senior and Veteran classes.
- Optional Cokeel and Mask in all categories.
- Any other change or request must be communicated before the category starts to the organization.
