### Article 1 Rules

- **1.** The <u>VII International and XVI Cup of Almeirim city</u>, with the date of May 12, 2024. Will be governed by the competition rules of FNK-P (WKF) and supervised by a National, European or World WKF Referee and others invited for this purpose.
- **2.** The **VII International and XVI City of Almeirim Karate Cup**, will have as competition directors Mr. Paulo Almeida and Mr. José Carlos Ferreira.

## Article 2 *Age groups*

1. The competitors are distributed by the following age groups on the date of the event:

#### 1.1 Kata

### Article 3 Weight Category - Kumite

- 1. Competitors are distributed in the following weight categories:
  - 1.1 In the class of **Initiates Men/Women** the weight categories are:
    - a) -Less than 40Kg
    - b) -Less than 44Kg
    - c) +More than 44 Kg
  - 1.2 In the class of **Men's Juvenile** the weight categories are:
    - a) -Less than 45Kg
    - b) -Less than 55Kg
    - c) +More than 55 Kg
  - 1.3 In the class of **Women's Juvenile** the weight categories are:
    - a) -Less than 50Kg
    - b) -Less than 50Kg
    - c) +More than 55 Kg
  - 1.4 In the class of **Men's Cadet** s the weight categories are:
    - a) -Less than 57Kg
    - b) -Less than 67Kg
    - c) +More than 67Kg
  - 1.5 In the class of **Cadet Women's** the weight categories are:
    - a) -Less than 54Kg
    - b) +More than 54Kg
  - 1.6 In the class of **Junior Men's** the weight categories are:
    - a) -Less than 61Kg
    - b) -Less than 71Kg
    - c) +More than 71 Kg
  - 1.7 In the class of **Junior Women's** the weight categories are:
    - a) -Less than 53Kg
    - b) +More than 53Kg
  - 1.8 In the class of **Senior Men's** the weight categories are:
    - a) -Less than 67Kg
    - b) -Less than 75Kg
    - c) +More than 75Kg
  - 1.9 In the class of **Senior Women's** the weight categories are:
    - a) Under 61Kg
    - b) Over 61Kg
  - 1.10 Weighing it will be done.

### Article 4 Representation

1. Each competitor represents the club for which they are affiliated or not affiliated in the Federation.

### Article 5 *Raffle*

1. The raffle of the competitors will be made at a place, date and time to be officially announced.

### Article 6 Dispute systems

- 1. The kumite competitions are done in a simple and direct elimination system, with recaps.
- 2. The kata competitions in the infantile, initiate, juvenile, cadet, junior and senior classes are done in a point system.

# Article 7 Registration

- 1. The registration of a competitor or club implies registration and payment immediately, if this is not done it will be nule.
- 2. The registration of athletes is from the entire responsibility of the coach/club.
- 3. The competitor or club, in order to be able to take part in the competition, needs to be equipped with of the respective identity card
- 4. In the absence of the identity card, the competitor may participate as long as he is registered in the competition and identifies himself with an official document.
- 5. Photocopies will not be accepted for registration purposes.
- 6. The registration of a competitor or club is done directly by the club.
- 7. The registrations are available on the CADCA website.
- 8. The deadline for registration is May 5, 2023. Registrations made later than this may be refused.
- 9. The list of subscribers is available in real time on the platform. After ending registrations, it is possible to request corrections until May 8. Raffle will be on May 9.

  Any change after May 8th will result in the payment of a new registration fee.

- 10. Each club can only enter 5 competitors in KATA and KUMITE.
- 11. Each competitor may only participate in one class.
- 12. For the registration of competitors and coaches in the event, the following must be observed:
  - a) Competitors and coaches must be registered for the event.
  - b) Competitors and coaches must be properly affiliated.
  - c) The competitors must have Sports Insurance up to date (the Organization is not responsible for any accidents that may occur during the competition).
  - d) The registration fee is 11 euros per **competitor and event** and 5 euros per coach.
  - e) Once the registration has been accepted, the registration fee will not be refunded.
  - f) Payment is made exclusively by bank transfer until the date of the PRE-RAFFLE to **IBAN PT50 0045 5472 4021297602865.** Send proof of the transfer to the registrations email, so that they can be moved from the "waiting list" to confirmed registrations.
  - g) Registrations are saved to a waiting list "Wainting List" and only move to Registration after payment. The waiting list does not guarantee registration if you reach the registration limit.

## Article 8 Accreditations

1. The accreditations will be made at the competition office, on May 11 between 20:00 and 22:30 and on May 12 between 08:00 and 12:00.

# Article 9 *Identification of competitors and trainers*

1. The organization will provide the trainers with identifiers to be distributed to the competitors, who must place them in a clearly visible place, without it they will not have access to the competition area.

### Article 10 *Belts*

1. Competitors must wear only the blue and red belts in the competition venue for the duration of the entire event.

### Article 11 Call for Competitors

- 1. The call for the competitors will be made at the appropriate place, after the announcement of the event and tatami where it will take place, with the indication of the first and last name.
- 2. The coach must indicate, at the time of the call, the eventual absence of the competitor, in order to avoid wasting time.
- 3. If any competitor is missing, 3 more calls will be made on the tatami where the competition will take place, after the calls are over they will be disqualified.

### A<mark>rt</mark>icle 12 Competito<mark>rs'</mark> accomp<mark>an</mark>iment

- 1. The coaches accredited by the organization may accompany their competitor in the competition without interfering in the course of the competition.
- 2. Coaches may give instructions to competitors in their own voice and only when the match is stopped or interrupted.
- 3. Once the competitor has finished their participation, both competitors must leave the competition area immediately.

### Article 13 Place of competition

- The competition will be played in the following areas:
   a) 4 Competition areas (Tatamis).
  - b) Calling Area.
  - c) 1 Warming area.

### Article 14 Classification and titles

1. The competition will have classifications in all classes and categories, with the respective attribution of trophies and titles.

### Article 15

#### **Trophies**

- 1. Trophies will be awarded at the end of the competitions in the following forms:
  - 1.1 Medals for the first, second and third place.
  - 1.2 Cups for the four highest scoring teams.

### Article 16 Anti-doping Control

1. The event may have anti-doping control and all competitors must comply with this obligation, if in case.

### A<mark>rt</mark>icle 17 Medical Team

1. The organization provides a medical and nursing team and a fire brigade during the race.

### Articl<mark>e 1</mark>8 *Prot<mark>est</mark>s*

- 1. Protests may only be submitted in writing by accredited coaches, during the course of the event.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the present committee at the match and the Competition organization (competition Directors) to deliberate on the protests.

1. The competition will take place at the Almeirim Municipal (ABC) Pavilion.

#### Article 20 Public

1. The entrance will be 1€ per person.

- 2. The competition will have a break between 13:00 and 14:30.

1. The resolution of doubts or omitted cases in the present regulation shall be decided by the competition Directors.

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
